SIMILE

comparing 2 unlike

things using like or as



My dad's

as
a house.

Metaphor

Makes a
COMPARISON
but does NOT
use the words
"like" or "as"

a dance,
a dream.

of two unlike things

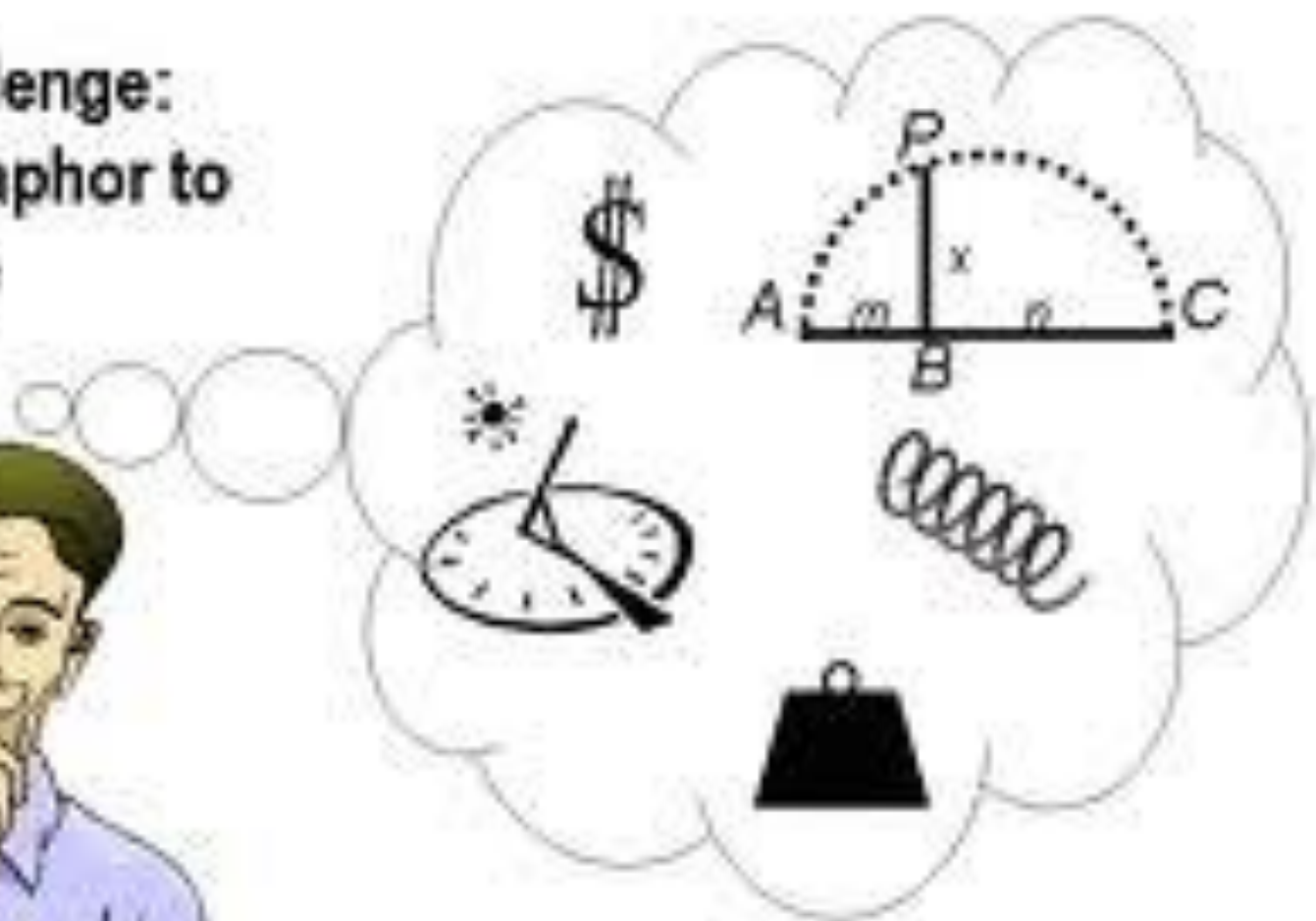


A Couch Potato
